Holt County Humane Society Foster Care Policies:

- The responsible party must be at least 21 years of age.
- The Holt County Humane Society will make every reasonable attempt to find a permanent home for foster pets within 60 days of arrival in their temporary home.
- If there will be more than three pets in the household (foster plus owned animals), the foster agreement must be pre-approved by at least one member of the HCHS board.
- Foster pets will be given a physical exam, temperament tested, spayed or neutered, and vaccinated prior to entering foster care unless there are extenuating circumstances. It is recommended to keep the foster pet isolated from other pets in the household for 5 days after arrival in the new home.
- Foster homes agree to provide adequate food, shelter and confinement (not allowed to roam free) to foster animals during their stay at their residence.
- The Holt County Humane Society will be responsible for the costs of medical care for the foster pet (not for owned animals) unless the health needs are due to negligence or failure to follow the above needs for food, shelter and confinement.
- Foster animals are the property of Holt County Humane Society and can be removed from foster care at the discretion of a board member (for reasons including neglect, abuse, etc).
